

CAPITALIZATION: The Word I

The letter I is both a letter and a word. When it is used as a word, it is capitalized. It is a word when:

- 1 It replaces your name in a sentence.
- 2 It is also a word when it is used by itself.

Correct Example:

I am good at reading.

Incorrect Example:

i am good at reading.
