

CONTRACTIONS: WASN'T AND WEREN'T

Wasn't and **weren't** are contractions that are used differently. You use the contraction **wasn't** when talking about one subject.

The girl **wasn't** at school today.

The girl is the subject.

Use the contraction **weren't** when you are talking about more than one subject. You should also use the contraction **weren't** when using the word **you**.

The girls **weren't** at school today.

There is more than one girl.
