

USING THE WORDS A AND AN

The words **a** and **an** are used to help identify nouns. They are used differently when writing sentences.

- Use the word **an** before a vowel sound.

Example

An ant is on the table.

- Use the word **a** before a consonant sound.

Example

The dog has a big toe.
