FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE List and give examples of the following:

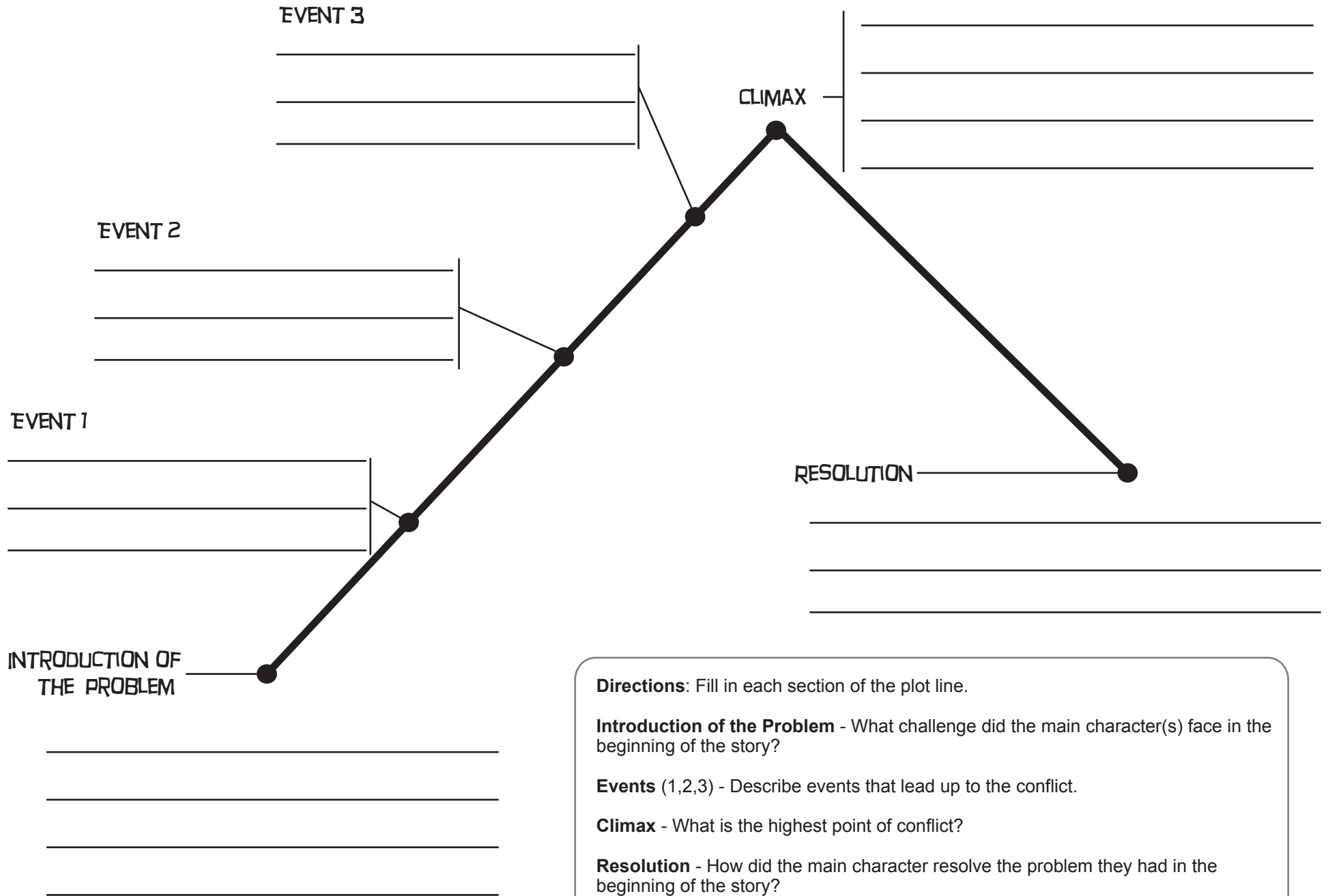
- SIMILE** A figure of speech comparing two unlike things, often introduced with the word "like" or "as" (Example: as fast as a rocket).

- METAPHOR** A way to describe something. Authors use them to make their writing more interesting or entertaining (Example: Her unkind words added *fuel to the fire*).

- ALLITERATION** A repeated occurrence of a consonant sound at the beginning of several words in the same phrase (Example: Silly Sam sold seven sandwiches).

- ONOMATOPOEIA** One or more words that suggest the source of the sound they are describing (Example: "Buzz!," "Oink," "Meow.")
